Noah builds an ark.

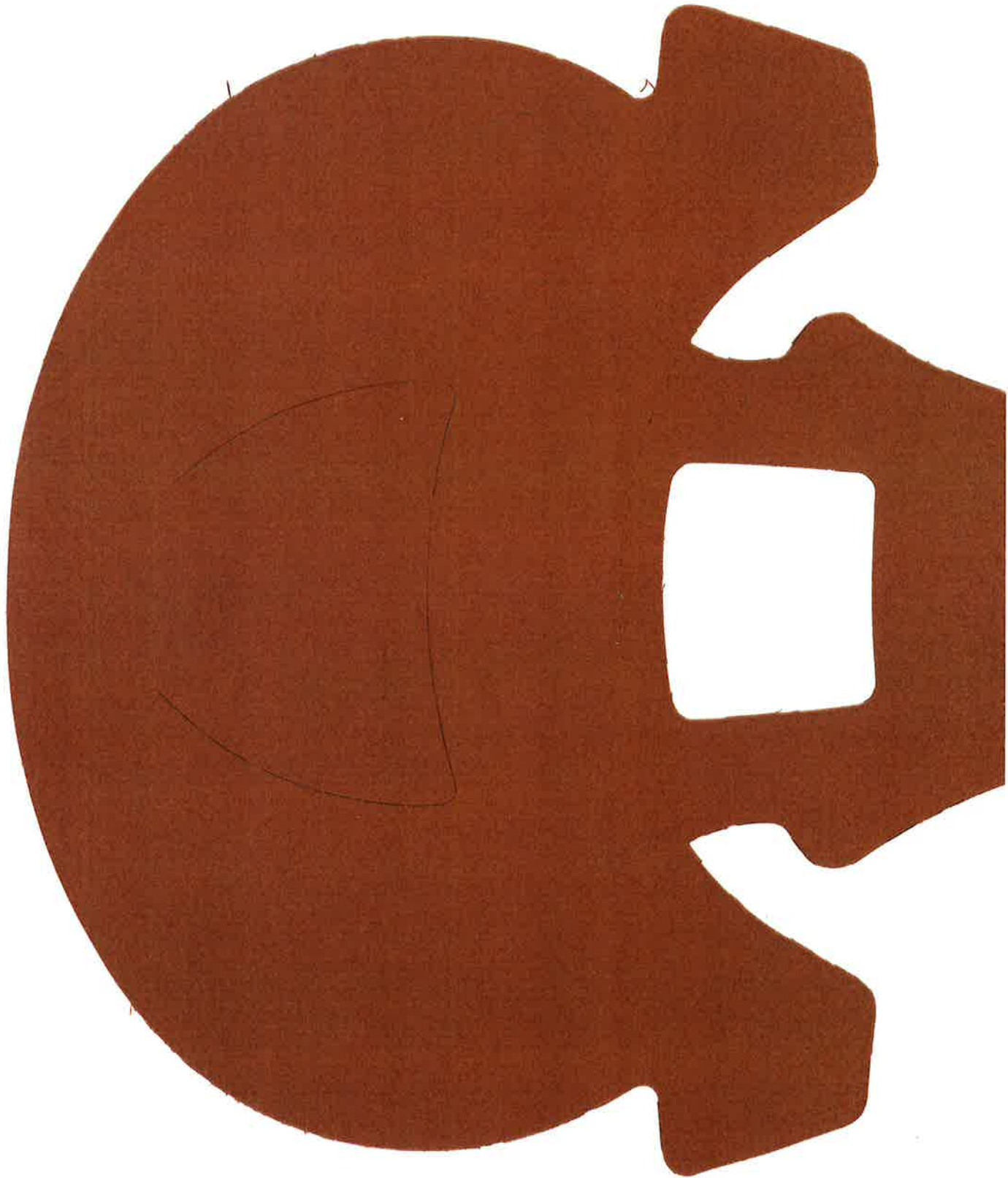

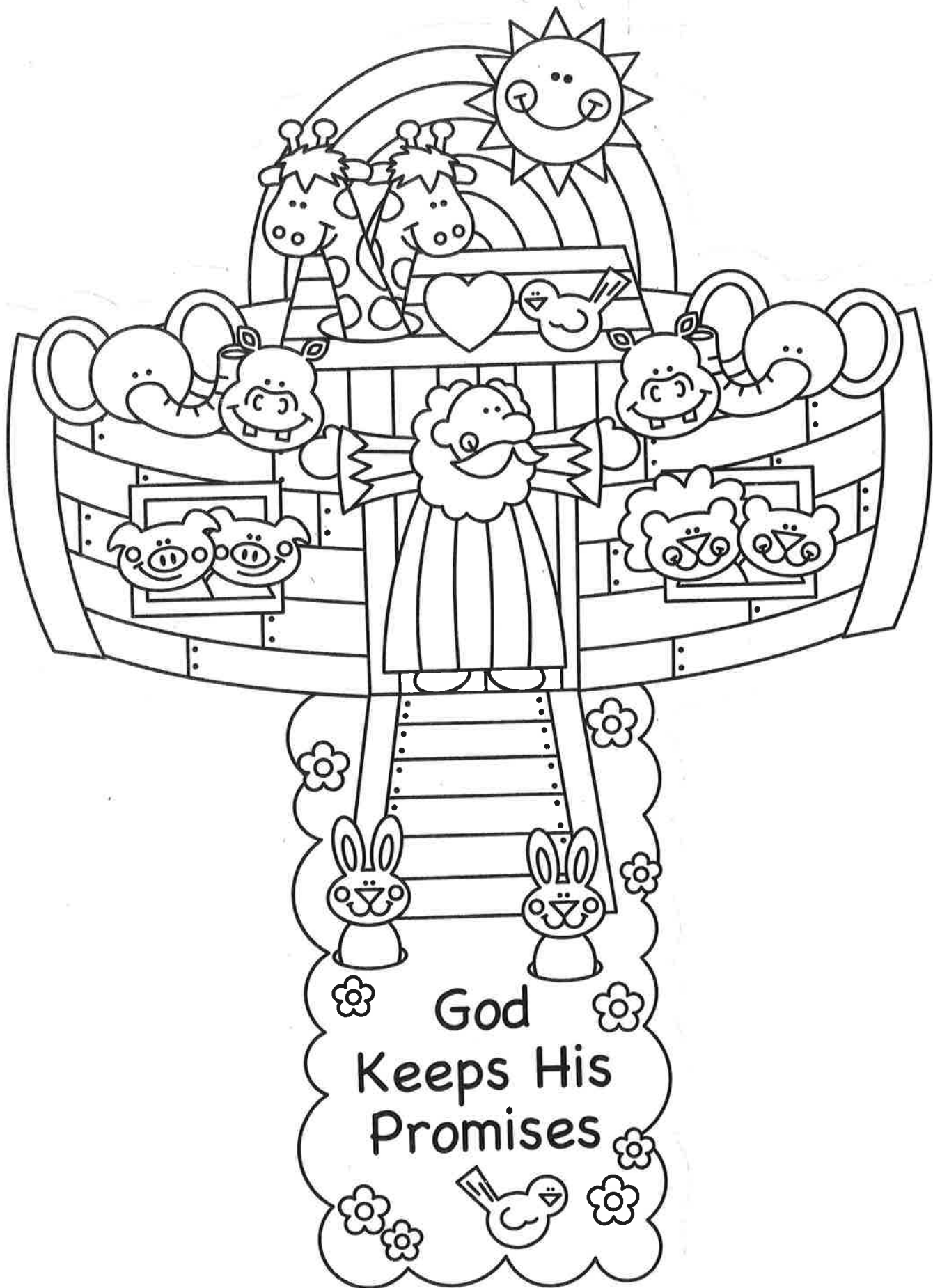

There was one person left who loved God. His name was Noah. Noah did what was right. God told Noah that He was going to send a flood to cover the whole world.

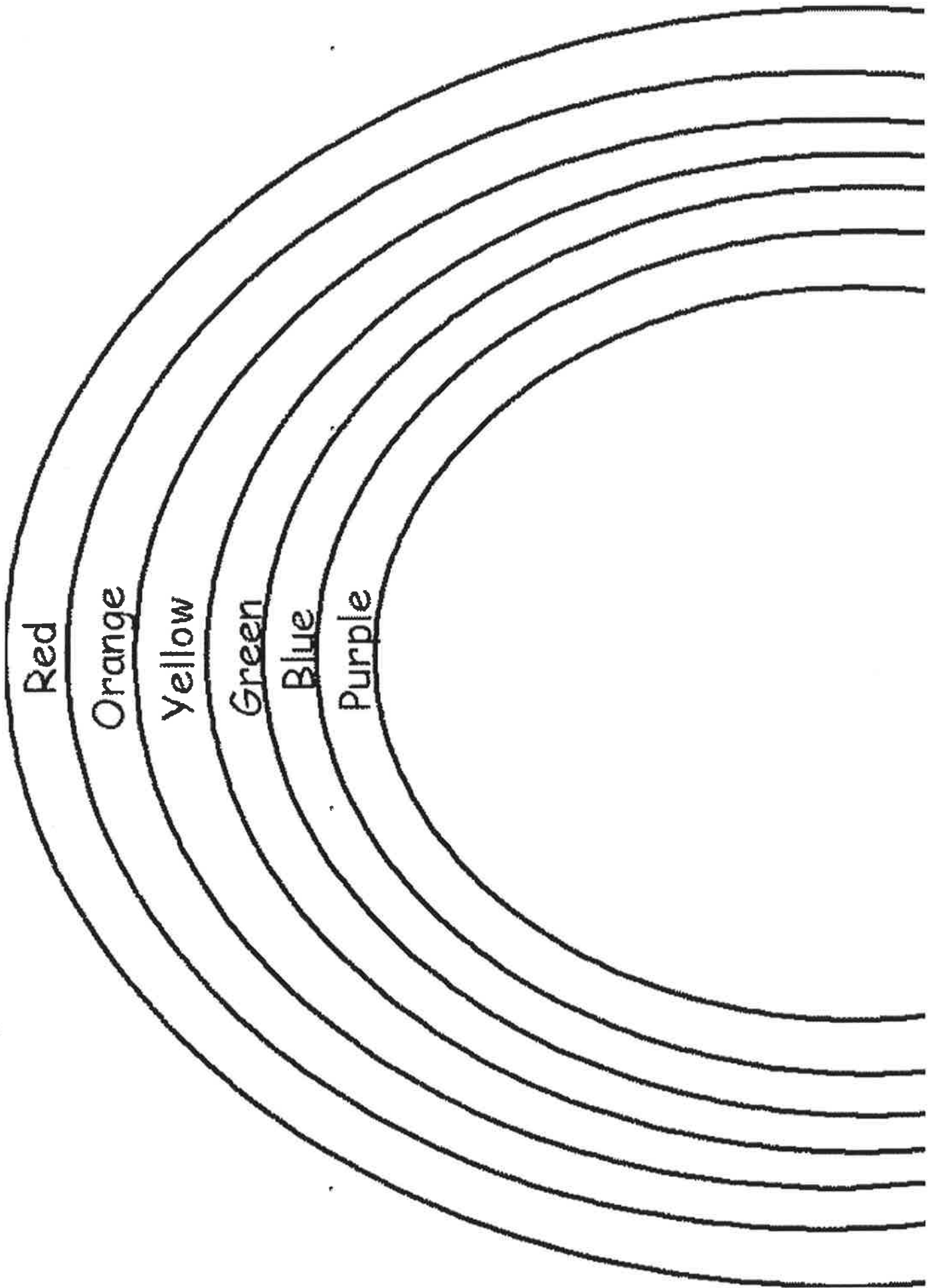
"Make a big boat," God told Noah. The boat was called an ark. Noah and his family would be safe in the ark when the flood came.
