Mark 16:9-13

#1 There will always be those who don't believe Jesus is resurrected!

What does the resurrection mean? Because of Christ resurrection we have the opportunity to encounter Him and be victorious.

#2 There will always be those who remember Christ resurrection because they are reminded.

Luke 24:5-8 - "They then remembered"

#3 There will always be those who strive to walk and live in the resurrection of Christ.

Luke 24:13-49 - "A walk one soon should not forget"

For three agonizing days, Satan thinks he's victorious. Jesus is dead and out of the way. Then the most spectacular events take place. Jesus shows up alive, that's right, the story is not over God's plan ends in victory, not death. Jesus has conquered the powers of death and hell not just for himself but for everyone.
