Community Group Questions

1. Discuss general impressions/takeaways from the message?
2. Reflect on this quote: “Real community is a biblical expression of the love that binds us all together. The “set your mind” verses don’t stop... they continue into an understanding of how we are bound together by more than our gifts. We are bound together by a Spirit-led-interconnectedness that we have to choose and keep choosing every day. Without it, the house cannot stand.”
3. Read and reflect on **Colossians 3:12-14 NIV**—“Therefore, as God’s chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. ¹³ Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. ¹⁴ And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.”
4. Reflect on this quote: “Theoretical grace is “the heretical” grace. Just as faith without works is dead, love without someone to whom it is intentionally expressed and demonstrated, especially in differences, difficulties and tension, is merely platitude.”
5. Review/discuss the Core Values of Community. Talk about ways you can more deeply pursue living out these values together.
