Paul's fullest explanation of the gospel, the good news, is about Jesus' life, death, and resurrection.

Romans 3:21 4:5, 7-8

Our faith practices and methods will change and evolve, yet they can never be the reflection of our life in the Spirit and commitment to Christ.

Because we want God to fit into our logic box, we discard any nonconforming Scripture, or simply ignore it. If we acknowledge the opposite Scriptural reference, our doctrine must be modified to accommodate both Scriptures.
